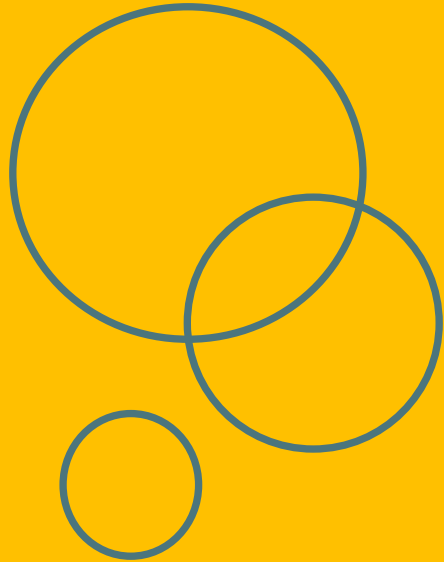
Hours for semesters

Suggest a purchase including a book, magazine, video or other materials which match your need.



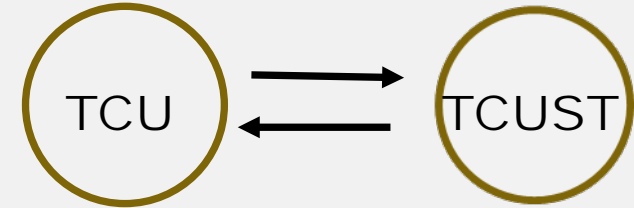

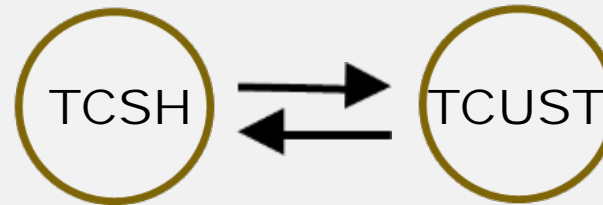

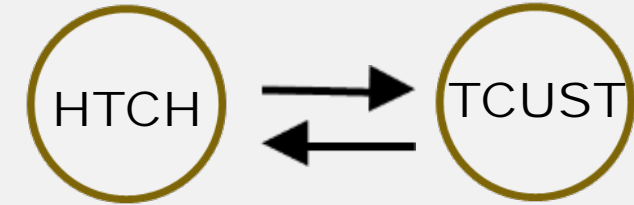

Step 1: Visit the website of TCUST Library

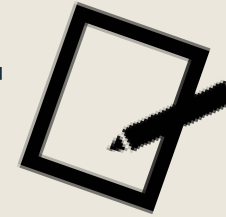


Step 2: Click the "Library Catalog Search"

How to borrow a book...

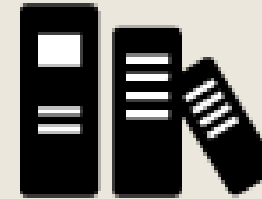


Step 3: Gathering the book information and identify the first two letters of the call number

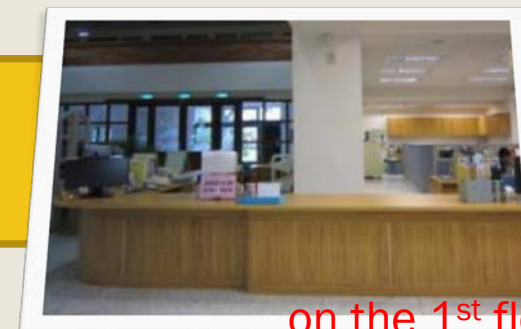


A call number is located at the bottom of the book's spine
